## Town Council Meeting

August 3, 2015 - Highlights

- ▶ Mr. Lee Patterson chaired the sitting of Council, in his capacity as acting mayor. He announced that the Jolibourg well was now contributing to the Town's drinking water system and reminded those in attendance that a public consultation on various Land Use and Planning by-laws would be held Thursday, August 6, 2015, at the Centre Lac-Brome, located at 270 Victoria Street.
- ▶ Council received and answered many questions concerning the project concerning an eventual aquatic center on the Town's territory.
- ▶ Council authorized several agreements (911, Recreation, Minor league hockey and figure skating), confirmed the permanence of the Director of Finance and Treasury, Mrs. Caroline Cusson, and adopted the Town's strategic planning for the 2015-2020 period.
- ▶ The list of immovables in default of paying municipal taxes was tabled.
- ▶ By-law 569-1 amending by-law (spending powers) was adopted.
- ▶ Council authorized the following expenses as financial contributions to following events or organizations: \$ 500 Yamaska Valley Optimist Club; \$ 9000, *Les Printemps meurtriers*.
- ▶ It also authorized the use of the public domain for the Yamaska Valley Optimist Club's "March against women's cancers" and the Brome Lake Optimist Club's fundraising "roadblock".
- ▶ Council also accepted the Office of Municipal Housing's 2015 budgetary revision.

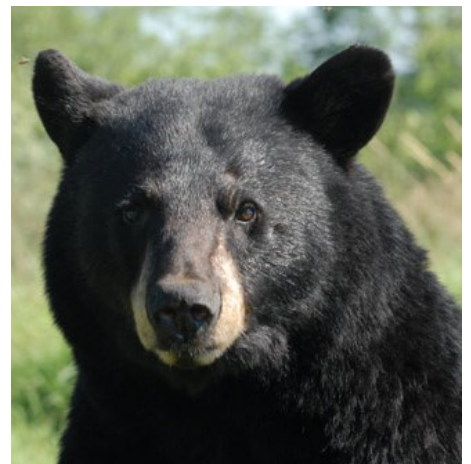
## Black Bears
