Sitting of Municipal Council

May 4, 2015 - Highlights

- ✂ Mayor Burcombe reminded citizens that there had been a public consultation on By-laws 596-1 (zoning), 596-2 (zoning), 597-1 (subdivision) and 601-1 (SPAIP) held at 10:00 a.m. April 11, 2015, at Centre Lac-Brome, located at 270 Victoria Street.
- ✂ Council awarded contracts for a total of \$ 261 683.10, taxes included, for the supply of crushed stone.
- ✂ It adopted By-law 596-1 to amend Zoning By-law 596: This Regulation does not contain provisions regarding the establishment of a rehabilitation center at 17 Victoria Street.
- ✂ Council also adopted two By-laws consistent with the Brome-Missisquoi RCM's Land use and Development Plan: By-law 596-2 to amend Zoning By-law 596 and By-law 597-1 to amend Subdivision By-law 597. By-law 601-1 amending By-law 601 (SPAIP) and Loan By-law 613 (road maintenance and repair) were also adopted.
- ✂ Council also adjusted the salaries of the Municipal Inspector, Environmental Inspector and Taxation clerk.
- ✂ It also authorized the following expenses in financial contributions: \$ 5 500, *Canada Day*; \$ 2 200, *Arts Alive*.
- ✂ Council also authorized the use of the public domain for various activities and dissolved the Path Committee, which will now report to Recreation and Community services of Brome Lake.

Tax payments : 2nd installment

The Town of Brome Lake wants to remind taxpayers that the 2nd installment is due on **June 16, 2015**.

Payment methods :

- Online banking
- Cheque (post-dated cheques accepted)
- Debit card at the reception desk at Town Hall
- Cash at the reception desk at Town Hall

Dust suppressant process (liquid calcium)

For effective results, the application of liquid calcium must be done when roads meet the following criteria;

- Surface thaw must reach a depth of 0.6 to 1 meter;
- Surface must be dry;
- Surface must be graded a maximum of one (1) day prior to the application of dust suppressant (so that the material is not overly compact in order for the liquid calcium to adequately seep through the surface).

The thaw period ending May 22, 2015 and many of the Town's roads still requiring a few hours of additional operations, the application of dust suppressant in Brome Lake will not begin before the week of June 1, 2015.

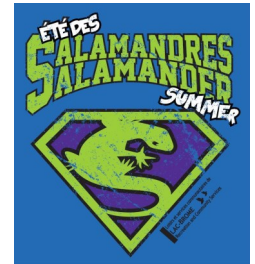

Garage Sales

Authorized period : May 1st to September 30 (duration : Saturday and Sunday, max 2 permits)

Exception 1 : Citizens who are moving (Anytime, with permits and supporting documents)

Exception 2 : Not-for-profit organizations (Anytime, free permit obtained in advance, max 1 permit)

Qualified people : Brome Lake residents

Cost of permits: \$ 10 (Free, if date of sale changed because of rain)

Special conditions : ART 6-8 BY-LAW. 492

Violation : \$ 300 fine

Putting-up signs on property that is not the subject of the permit is prohibited. The list of properties that will hold a garage sale will be on the Town's website each Friday.
