Town Council Meeting October 3, 2016 - Highlights

- ▶ Mayor Richard Burcombe presides over the sitting of Council. He thanks the organizers of the 2017 editions of *Canard en fête* and the *Walk against cancer*. He tables the 2017 (summary) assessment roll.
- ▶ Besides the usual expenditure authorizations, Council authorizes: signing of an agreement regarding stabilization work on lot 4 265 685; an agreement on the scope of the warranty concerning installation of support pillars for the Quilliams footbridges; the modification of contract AO 2016-10, in the amount of \$ 17 000, plus taxes; grant requests for the replacement of water and sewages pipes via the *Fonds pour l'eau potable et le traitement des eaux usées* (FEPTEU).
- ▶ Council awards a general representation mandate to Monty Sylvestre attorneys, and authorizes the hiring of a Fire prevention officer, the striking of bad municipal debts and the sale of municipal surplus assets.
- ▶ Notice of motion is given concerning the upcoming adoption of two loan by-laws concerning the municipalisation of water and waste water infrastructures at the West-Brome mobile home park and adopts a Fire safety By-law.
- ▶ Besides the usual land use and planning items, Council expressed support for a project presented to the Brome-Missisquoi MRC by Renaissance Lac Brome (*Aménagement d'un ruisseau tributaire du Lac Brome*)
- ▶ It designates the persons responsible for the application of section 32 of the *Fire safety Act* and the Town's Fire safety By-law.
- ▶ It authorizes the organizers of the "Bromont Ultra" foot-race to use the public domain.
- ▶ It authorizes the modification of the Town's Conservation calendar so that it may include rules concerning substitution of documents by scanning technology.
- ▶ It authorizes, under certain conditions, the extension of asphaltting on unpaved sections of road provided that costs be covered by the land owner making the request.

Special Town Council Meeting October 12, 2016 - Highlights

- ▶ Mayor Richard Burcombe presides over the sitting of Council. Council awards *Les Agences de l'Est P.V. Inc.* the AO 2016-20 contract in the amount of \$ 62 603,88 to provide and install a shelter for Lions Park.
- ▶ It also awards the AO 2016-21 contract to *Pavages Maska Inc.* to lay asphalt at the municipal garage.
- ▶ It adopts By-law 2016-06 decreeing an expense and a loan of \$ 200 000 to realize the necessary plans and specifications for the work concerning the municipalized infrastructures of the West-Brome mobile homes park.

Parking

Winter parking regulations will soon be in effect!

Overnight Parking

There is **no parking allowed** on the Town's public roads **between 11 pm and 7 am, November 15 to March 31.**

This ban does not apply between **December 23 and January 3.**

Snow Clearing

Please do not obstruct snow removal. **No parking is allowed where signs are posted.**

Signs forbidding overnight parking will soon be installed in the following Town car parks:

- Lakeside Rd, next to *Star Café*
- Knowlton Rd, behind the *Uniprix* pharmacy
- Knowlton Rd, next to KDC

Our goal is to make snow clearing as efficient as possible, for everyone's safety.

Temporary Car Shelters

Regulations

Between October 15th of one year and April 30th of the following year, one or two temporary car shelters may be installed in the front or side yard to store a maximum of 2 automobiles per property.

Outside of this period, these temporary shelters must be removed.

For residential uses, temporary shelters may be installed 1 m from the edge of the sidewalk or at last 2 m from the asphalt surface or, should the road not be paved, at least 3 m from the road right-of-way.

At the intersections of roads, a minimum distance of 3 m from the edge of the right-of-way shall be observed for the first 15 m so as not to interfere with visibility or snow removal.
