## Town Council Meeting September 6, 2016 - Highlights

- ▶ Mayor Richard Burcombe presides over the sitting of Council. He tables a letter from the *ministère de la Sécurité publique* concerning police services and a judgment upholding the Town's decision refusing to issue a permit for the installation of a dock.
- ▶ Besides the usual expenditure authorizations, Council authorizes various agreements concerning: the creation of a Public works coordinator position, the municipalisation of water and waste water infrastructures at the West-Brome mobile home park, the use of a fire hydrant, victims disaster relief and stabilization works on a land parcel.
- ▶ It awards *Jean-Pierre Cadrin & Ass.* contract AO 2016-16 in the amount of \$ 149 007.60, including taxes, for the property assessment for the next six years and contract AO 2016-17 in the amount of \$ 27 938.93, including taxes, to *Les Consultants S.M. Inc.* for a concept plan for Victoria Street. It also authorizes a further expense of \$ 52 543.50, plus taxes, for contract AO 2016-19 concerning the installation of footbridges for the Quilliams path.
- ▶ It authorizes a request to the MDDELCC for a certificate of authorization for works on various lots.
- ▶ It authorizes the creation of a Public works coordinator position.
- ▶ Notice of motion is given regarding a fire safety by-law.
- ▶ Council adopts amendments to the codes of ethics and professional conduct of both elected officials and municipal employees.
- ▶ It adopts various land use and planning by-laws concerning the Town's Planning program as well as its zoning, subdivision, construction and SPAIP by-laws.
- ▶ It designates SPA des Cantons responsible for the application of the Town's By-law concerning animals.
- ▶ Besides the usual land use and planning items, Council allows various agencies to use the public domain. It authorizes an expense of \$ 5 000 for the creation of a web site to promote film and television productions in Brome-Lake. It supports the Heart Foundation's financing activities and mandates councillor Louise Morin to represent it at *Fondation Rues principales'* 29<sup>th</sup> annual conference.
