PUBLIC NOTICE

**BY-LAW 2026-05
BY-LAW CONCERNING THE REMUNERATION
OF ELECTED MUNICIPAL OFFICERS**

At a regular sitting of the Town Council held on March 2, 2026, notice of motion was given that By-law 2026-05 (by-law concerning the remuneration of elected municipal officers) would be adopted at the regular sitting of Council to be held at 7:00 p.m., on April 7, 2026, at Centre Lac Brome, 270 Victoria Street, Brome Lake.

The draft of this by-law was presented at the same sitting at which the notice of motion was given. The purpose of by-law 2026-05 is to set the remuneration of elected municipal officials (1 mayor and 6 councillors) and their expense allowances. The by-law also provides that the remuneration of elected officers and their expense allowances will be indexed upward for each fiscal year starting from the one that begins after its coming into force. It also provides that the Town will pay the *pro tempore* mayor additional remuneration sufficient to receive, from that time and until the replacement ends, an amount equal to the mayor's remuneration when the replacement period reaches the number of days required. This by-law will be retroactive to January 1, 2026, the year of its coming into force.

The following table contains the mention of each current and proposed remuneration as well as the current and proposed expense allowances:
