The Town of Lac-Brome is requesting bids for the work described above. Bids must be submitted in a sealed envelope bearing the inscription “VLB-2026-01 – Road Construction – Reconstruction of Fulford Road and addition of bike lanes”, and the bidder must be clearly identified.

Tender documents may be obtained exclusively through the Electronic Tendering System (SÉAO) at www.seao.ca, in accordance with the costs and terms of that system, starting **February 20, 2026**.

To be considered, all bids must be accompanied by a bid security as described in Article IV-1.1 of the “Notice to Bidders” of standard BNQ 1809-900/2019. The bid, the required bid security, and all other documents to be submitted shall be deemed valid for a period of 90 days. Bidders must take this requirement into account when having documents completed by third parties.

Only surety bonds issued by companies holding an insurer's license in Canada will be accepted under the terms of the tender documents.

Only bids submitted by contractors who have ordered the tender documents under the same name as the one under which they are submitting their bid will be considered. In the case of a consortium, this requirement is deemed satisfied when each party has obtained the documents.

For the purposes of awarding the contract, only bids from contractors with an establishment in Québec or, when an intergovernmental trade liberalization agreement applies, in a province or territory covered by such agreement, will be considered. Contractors must hold the required license under the Building Act (R.S.Q., c. B-1.1).

Bids must be received at Town Hall by Owen Falquero, Director of Legal Affairs, at the address indicated above, on or before **March 26, 2026, at 11:00 a.m.**, and will be publicly opened at the same time and place.

The awarding of the contract is conditional upon the approval of financial assistance under the PAVL program of the Ministry of Transport and Sustainable Mobility. It is also conditional upon the approval of the borrowing by-law by the MAMH.

The Town of Lac-Brome does not commit to accepting the lowest or any of the bids received.
